Many Delta passengers gain access to media they don't subscribe to at home, including programming from premium channels such as Showtime and HBO. The 300-movie catalog also includes popular new films such as Tenet and Mulan.

Delta's inflight Wi-Fi operates on the GoGo 2Ku satellite system, which offers about 100 Mbp/s per plane.

## Honorable Mention – JetBlue

-  JetBlue made news in 2020 by becoming the first national carrier to offer free Wi-Fi on all flights
-  JetBlue advertised a 12 to 20 Mbp/s speed for each device on their flights, comparable to paid Wi-Fi on Delta and Virgin America
-  JetBlue also has a partnership with Amazon to award customers three "TrueBlue" frequent flyer points when they make Amazon purchases through JetBlue's proprietary ShopTrue platform
