

# Where Can Inflight Entertainment Be Installed in Aircraft Cabins?

- » Bulkheads
- » Seatbacks
- » Armchairs
- » Wall-mounted displays
- » Credenza mounted displays on articulating arms and lifts
- » Virtual windows and skylights

Although they're not always used for displaying movies or TV shows, advancements in OLED technology are allowing some commercial and private jet owners to equip their cabins with monitors and displays of varying size and shape on all types of surfaces.



## Front-of-Cabin Centralized Television Screens

In the early days of inflight movies, passengers would need to look ahead to a single TV screen at the front of their cabin section.

## Periodic Ceiling Monitors

Cabins were equipped with more displays in the ensuing decades. Before the era of seatback screens, airlines added more ceiling-mounted monitors along the center aisle. These monitors were generally placed every few rows so people could watch a closer monitor instead of struggling to see the TV at the front of the aircraft cabin.

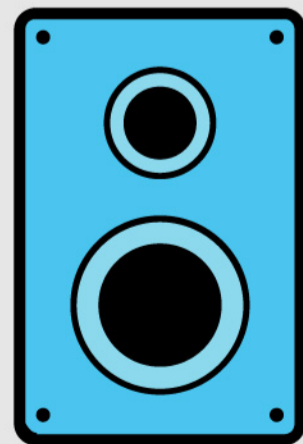
## Armrest Headphone Jacks

In the later half of the 20th century, passengers were able to jack into centralized audio entertainment systems and use rudimentary channel controls to switch between onboard audio entertainment and information. These channels often included:

- » Different genres of music
- » News bulletins or current affairs
- » Documentaries
- » Comedy

## Real-Time Flight Information

One of the features that became easily accessible thanks to personal seatback screens was real-time flight information. These systems allowed passengers to see their flight's current location, travel time, estimated time to destination, flight speed and other information about the flight.



## High Resolution Audio

There are countless audio solutions available for modern aircraft cabins. Most commercial airlines still reserve plane-wide speakers for announcements and crew communication, but private jets, business jets and charters sometimes install more robust sound systems for music, movies and TV.
